



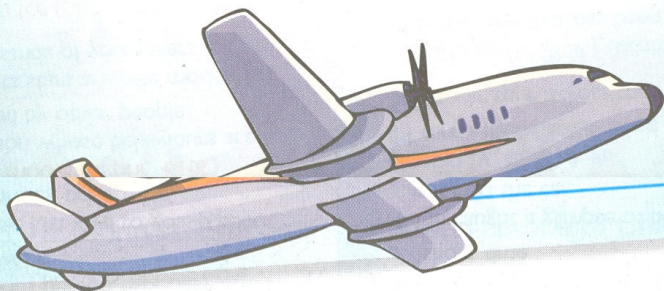
My favourite teacher is Miss Siu. She was my General Studies teacher when I was in primary three. She left us and went to England to study.
